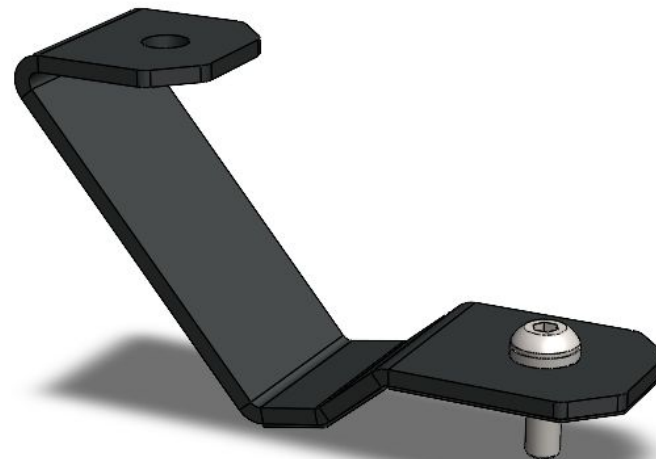

Remove existing panel bolt



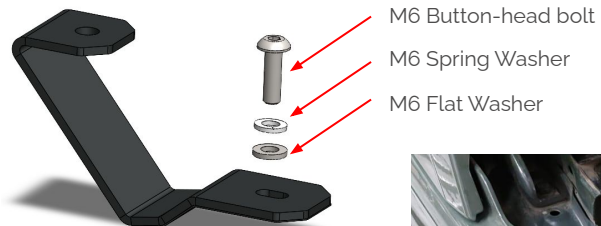
Remove standard M6 bolt
from vehicle panel using a
10mm Spanner / Wrench /
Socket

Replace the standard bolt with the M6 button head, spring washer and flat washer supplied

Repeat the steps for the other side of the vehicle and then mount your preferred spot light onto the bracket.
